



**Kindergarten Supply List

- 3 three-prong paper pocket folders** – one each of red, blue, green
- 2 Composition notebook** (NOT spiral) one regular, one primary (see example on back)
- 6 boxes of 24 count Crayola crayons**
- 2 package of ten #2 yellow pre-sharpened pencils**
- 8 large solid glue sticks** (at least 0.7 oz.)
- 1 pair of blunt/rounded scissors**
- 3 reams of copy paper**
- 1 backpack** – NO rolling backpacks
- 1 plastic rest mat** – NO fabric mats, blankets, or towels.
- 4 rolls of paper towels**
- 1 box of Kleenex**
- 1 boxes or refill packages of baby wipes**
- 1 bottle of liquid pump hand soap**
- 1 bottle of waterless hand sanitizer** (8 oz. or larger) – NOT LIQUID SOAP
- 1 box of tall kitchen trash can liners**
- 1 large package of Clorox Wipes**

Girls

- 1 box of classic colors washable markers**
- 1 box of ziploc sandwich bags**
- 1 box of quart size storage/freezer bags**

Boys

- 1 package of construction paper** (NOT tablet)
- 1 roll masking tape**
- 1 box of gallon size storage/freezer bags**

We also use the following items that you may also send:

colored copy paper envelopes cardstock clothespins

A \$30 donation will be asked of each child.
